*Attendance*

*Reports*

*President*

- The president's report was included in discussion of other reports.
- UK Elite camp dates have been set for June 28 – July 2. Cost reportedly will be approximately \$80 - \$100 per player.
- UK Elite is also willing to send a trainer to team practices. They will need to know in advance how many teams might be interested. This would be ideal for teams preparing for a special tournament, etc.

*Registrar/ TCPJSA*

- Rosters have been frozen for all teams except those playing in spring leagues. IE U17 girls.
- The Commissioners Cup registration deadline is November 10. The Challenge Cup deadline is December 8. Transfers to teams playing in these tournaments are limited.

*Fields*

- There are school fields available for practices from 4:00 until dark. Let Scott Falk know if you need field time.
- There was discussion concerning whether the club should charge a fee for games at the Chambers fields. It was decided that the club would cover the fees for games at those fields.
- There was also discussion about the need for new nets at the stadium. The school is aware of this but has not taken action as of yet.

#### *Referees*

- Referees have been paid for September and the invoices for October have been submitted. No issues concerning referee pay were raised.
- There was a report of two games with missing referees due to schedule changes. Teams should be sure to not only communicate schedule changes between teams but also to the referees.
