Reports

President

- The president's report was deferred and included in discussion of other reports.

- The State Cup registration deadline is November 1.
- There have been over 260 Saturday games association-wide. This has meant that there are not enough referees to cover all the games. Teams are again urged to get parents, older siblings, grandparents, etc. certified or re-certified so they can fill-in in a pinch.
- There will be a new camp available called Kidz Love Soccer. It is sponsored by a group from California.

Stadium Coordinator

- Starting in November there will be much more time available. In the past slots have generally been doled out to the more competitive and longest running teams. There is a hierarchy of sorts.
